

*ROSS TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS  
MEETING  
FEBRUARY 2, 2009*

*The Regular Monthly meeting of the Ross Township Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Beers with members Vice Chairman Kresge and Supervisor Drake present. Solicitor Dunn was also present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all present.*

*The first order of business was a Public Hearing on the Adoption of a Proposed Stormwater Ordinance. Chairman Beers noted receipt of an extensive list of comments from Russ Kresge, Township Engineer after his review. A motion was made by Chairman Beers to table this matter and re-advertise at a later date another public hearing. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Drake and carried.*

*The minutes of both the January Reorganization meeting and the January Regular meeting were next on the agenda and a motion was made by Supervisor Drake to accept both as presented. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Kresge and carried.*

*After a review of the Treasurer's Report, a motion was made by Vice Chairman Kresge to accept as presented. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Drake and carried.*

*OPEN TO THE PUBLIC-Mr. Gerald Alvino a resident of Jacklyn Drive was present and spoke of a problem he is experiencing with a neighbor who is hampering the snow removal process by placing obstructions in the road protecting his driveway. Mr. Alvino noted that the school bus is having a problem turning around because of this situation and does not come down to the cul de sac. There were other residents who spoke of this problem that Mr. Alvino described. Chairman Beers noted that it will be taken care of. The residents complimented the Township personnel by expressing how well they do the plowing, etc..*

*CORRESPONDENCE-Chairman Beers noted receipt of a letter from Aqua Pa., Inc. noting some waterline replacement work to be done. Chairman Beers said since there just replacing lines he feels its maintenance. There were no objections or comments on this request. The Secretary noted that the Planning Commission addressed this at their last meeting and wrote a favorable response.*

*Supervisor Drake reported that the Pocono Land Trust wrote a letter of interest on the property discussed a few meetings ago and he should be contacting them if he is interested in selling.*

*After a review of the bills to be paid, Supervisor Drake made a motion to pay them as presented. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Kresge and carried.*
